The UM Staff Council's COMPASS committee is pleased to say that one of your employees has applied for and been accepted into our staff mentoring program as a mentor or mentee.

COMPASS: Moving in the Right Direction is a voluntary mentoring program for members of the Ole Miss community who wish to grow professionally and personally through mentor/mentee relationships. Each mentor/mentee is asked to commit to a one-semester term in the program; to make reasonable efforts to meet in person for approximately one hour at least monthly during the semester; and to communicate by phone or email at least every other week during the semester. Meetings will be held on campus. Additionally, mentors are required to attend a mentoring workshop provided on campus by the Human Resources Department. The meetings may or may not require time away from work. The workshop for mentors will be scheduled sometime during the normal 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. workday.

Your employee's participation in this program is an excellent opportunity for personal and professional growth.
